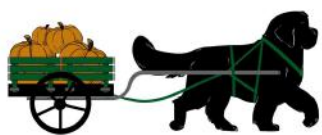

Canine Good Citizen:



Canine Good Citizen Test Items:

- 1) Dogs MUST be old enough to have received necessary immunizations such as rabies vaccines, however there is NO AGE LIMIT for taking just the CGC test. Mixed breeds are welcome!
- 2) Bring your dog's grooming brush with you.
- 3) Have your dog on a six-foot leash (NO retractable leashes).
- 4) Have either dog license or AKC Registration number.
- 5) Dogs MUST wear either a buckle or training collar (NO prong or pinch collars - NO head halters, i.e., Gentle Leader, Halties).
- 6) During the testing, NO treats or toys will be allowed.

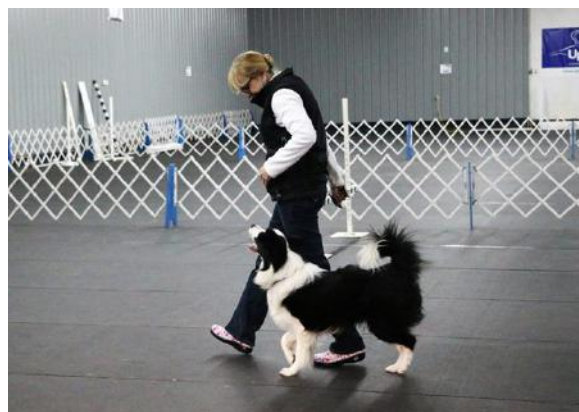

TRICKS CHECKLIST: NOVICE

Instructions: Dog Owner: send this page with the AKC Trick Dog Title Application to AKC.

Evaluator: Send this completed form to the dog owner. As of August 2022, Evaluators no longer send a copy to AKC.

A TOTAL OF **10 TRICKS** ARE REQUIRED TO EARN THE AKC NOVICE TRICK DOG TITLE.

If you have a Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate or title on record at AKC, you may count the CGC as 5 of the required tricks for the NOVICE TRICK DOG TITLE.

CGC Skills

Foundation Behaviors for Trick Training

1. Accepts friendly stranger
2. Sits politely for petting
3. Appearance and Grooming
4. Out for a Walk
5. Walking through a crowd
6. Sit, Down, Stay in place
7. Coming when called
8. Reaction to another dog
9. Reaction to distractions
10. Supervised Separation

- ___ Push-ups (sit, down, sit, down, sit, down)
- ___ Shake hands
- ___ Spin in circle
- ___ Touch it (hand or target stick)
- ___ Tunnel (agility tunnel or child's tunnel)

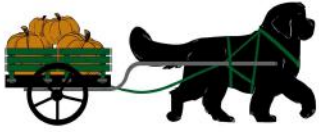

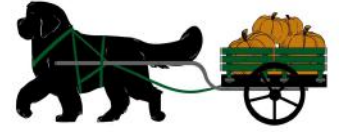

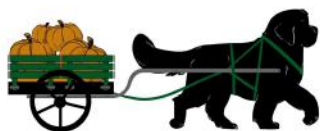


Explore and learn about some of the world's most amazing animals through our educational Wolf Watch tours. You can enjoy either a scenic 1/2 mile nature walk from the parking area to the preserve or we have a shuttle bus that can drive you there. Once you're at the preserve, you will be invited into the observation area where you will be surrounded by 4 different packs of wolves.

Directions to Park:



North NJ via NJ Turnpike:

- Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 8 at Hightstown.
- Keep left to get on Route 133 West.
- Take Exit for 571 towards Princeton.
- Take first left onto Old Trenton Rd immediately after Route 133.
- Drive 3.4 miles and make a right onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

South NJ via NJ Turnpike:

(Delaware)

- Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A.
- Follow West on I-195 to Exit 5B.
- Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light (Route 33 and Route 526).
- Turn left at light, and stay in the right lane.
- Turn right onto Robbinsville Edinburg Rd.
- Continue until the road ends and turn right onto Mercerville-Edinburg Rd/Old Trenton Rd.
- Take first left onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

Central/Western Pennsylvania:

- Go East on PA Turnpike 276.
- Take Exit 351 to merge onto US-1 North.
- Keep right to stay on US-1 North. Enter NJ.
- Take the Whitehead Rd Exit. Keep right at the fork and merge onto Whitehead Rd.
- Turn left onto Sweetbriar Ave.
- Sweetbriar Ave turns into Sloan Ave, which then turns into Flock Rd, but continue straight.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

Central/Eastern NJ:

- Use I-195 and head West.
- Take Exit 7 toward Washington and merge onto Route 526.
- Continue straight onto NJ Route 33. Stay in right lane.
- Use right lane to turn right onto Robbinsville Edinburg Rd.
- Continue until the road ends and turn right onto Mercerville-Edinburg Rd/Old Trenton Rd.
- Take first left onto Edinburg Rd.
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

South NJ via I-295:

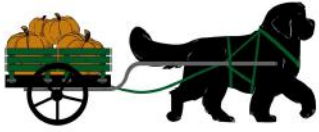
(Delaware)

- Use I-295 North and take Exit 65A towards Sloan Ave East.
- Continue straight onto Sloan Ave. The road then becomes Flock Rd.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.

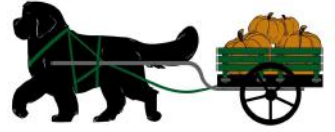
Northern Pennsylvania:

- Use I-476 South towards Philadelphia.
- Take the Exit onto I-276 East towards NJ.
- Take Exit 351 to merge onto US-1 North.
- Keep right to stay on US-1 North. Enter NJ.
- Take the Whitehead Rd Exit. Keep right at the fork and merge onto Whitehead Rd.
- Turn left onto Sweetbriar Ave.
- Sweetbriar Ave turns into Sloan Ave, which then turns into Flock Rd, but continue straight.
- Turn left onto Edinburg Rd (Route 535).
- At third traffic light, turn left onto Edinburg Rd. (Go passed main entrance)
- Mercer Park East is on the left.
